3.30 p.m. – Approximate departure on Tram.

5:00 p.m. – Approximate arrival at UNM.

- Lunch for the crest.
- Daypack/ backpack for carrying water, personal items, and layers
- Sunglasses with a strap.
- Appropriate hiking shoes or boots.
- Light jacket
