Located in La Cienega Valley, this natural wetland has numerous artesian springs that drain into two converging creeks that meet at the Santa Fe River at the south end of the valley. The water from these artesian springs is refreshingly cold and pure; it is free from contaminants because it has been protected through many layers of rock on its way to the surface. Join us as we soak in the thermal pools and relax in the peace that the spa has to offer.

9:00a.m. – Meet at the OAC and depart for Ojo Santa Fe.

10:00a.m. – Arrival at Ojo Santa Fe.

4:00p.m. – Head back to UNM.

5:00p.m. – Approximate arrival.

- Swimsuit.
