

SUP on the Rio!

Mandatory Pre-Trip Meeting: July 16th - 5:00pm @ the UNM Outdoor Adventure Center. See map below for location details.

Join the OAC for a half day floating on the Rio Grande. In addition to testing your SUP or packraft skills, you'll get to see the city's natural world on full display. We'll cover some river miles and have a built-in break for lunch. Cost includes equipment, guides, and transportation.

9:00 a.m. – Meet at the outside door of the Outdoor Adventure Center on the Southeast side of Johnson Center. You are welcome to park in the A-lot for the day. Be sure to bring your lunch and 2 liters of water.

9:30a.m. – Approximate arrival at put in. Pump up SUPs/rafts and rig them out. Set sail.

11:30a.m. – Approximate Lunch stop.

1:30p.m. – Depart for UNM OAC.

3:00p.m. – Approximate arrival at UNM OAC.

What to bring:

- At least 2 liters of water.
- Snacks and Lunch.
- Sunscreen. New Mexico mountain sun can be intense!
- Chacos/Keens/Teva's or shoes you don't mind getting wet.
- Sunglasses with a strap.
- Light towel.
- No Cotton.
- Sunhat or ball cap.
